Hatchery Report

Another successful year at the hatchery has come to an end. We had fish in the hatchery for longer than many year. We ended up with two lots of brown trout, one lot of 5000 smaller fish at just under 4" and another lot from the eggs that got left behind of 4000 to 5".

The release was done in two lots one on the August 11th and the other on the August 18th. Once again the fish went to Kitchener Waterloo area. Drops were made in Kolt Creek, Hopewell Creek and into the Grand River.

Thanks to all who helped in the raising and release of the fish. We had some real challenging areas to reach the waters in some cases. In my next report I will give some more information and ideas about the hatchery

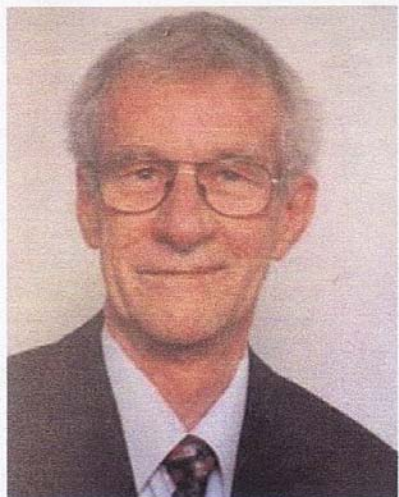
